The Massachusetts "Lemon Law," G.L.c. 90, Section 7N ½, obligates an auto manufacturer or dealer to repair any "nonconformity" to express or implied warranties – in other words, any defect that substantially impairs a vehicle's use, market value or safety – that arises within one year or 15,000 miles of the purchase of a new vehicle.
