EXEMPTION FROM TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

To Whom It May Concern:

_____ is a motor carrier subject to the Interstate Commerce Act, 49 U.S.C. § 10101, *et seq.*, and is part of the nation's critical infrastructure as defined by 42 U.S.C. § 5195c(e), Presidential Policy Directive 21 (PPD-21), Memorandum on Identification of Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers During COVID-19 Response, U.S. Department of Homeland Security dated March 19, 2020, and the U.S. Department of Transportation. _____ is a related logistics company that provides additional transportation and logistics services. The continued operation of _____ and _____ is necessary to the nation's essential critical infrastructure as defined by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. _____ and _____ provide essential critical infrastructure services to food and agriculture, the energy industry (both power generation and oil and gas), water, wastewater, solid waste, public works, chemicals, and other industries which will be vital to the nation's ability to respond to and persevere through the current pandemic emergency.

The bearer of this letter is an employee or independent contractor for _____ and _____, including but not limited to: drivers; maintenance and repair technicians; rail, barge and lake vessel terminal port workers; dispatchers; safety personnel; equipment operators; and clerical and support staff. Their efforts are essential to _____ an _____ continued operations during this crisis and the health, safety, and security of the nation.

Therefore, this person is exempt from any local, state, and/or federal restrictions on travel or work outside the home imposed in connection with pandemic control measures. Accordingly, as a matter of federal law, you may not prevent, delay, or otherwise interfere with the performance of this person's duties for Beelman.
